LOCATION

Location is vital to the success of your SkateDock® campaign. The SkateDock® must be placed in a **High Visibility** indoor or outdoor area, preferably near an entrance or near windows to deter theft.



EDUCATION

LIBRARY ENTRANCE

Use emails, flyers and teacher influence to educate students about SkateDocks[®].

Students are primarily concerned about security: educate them on the Lockable part of the SkateDock for faster adoption.

Send SkateDock[®] information and policies as part of the informational package sent to students before the year starts.



ENFORCEMENT

Enforcing the skateboard parking standard will ensure the effectiveness of your effort.

Use abundant Signage to inform students of policies, including no skateboards in the classroom or no riding zones. Educational signage informs students to Dock It and Lock It[®].
